OFFICIAL EVENT RULES

ONLY Official Cub Scout Pinewood Derby Cars or their equivalent are to be used. The cars may be cut, sanded, and accessorized as desired but they must meet the following criteria to be permitted to race.

- 1. The Judge's ruling is considered final.
- 2. Cars must pass Judge's inspection. If a car fails inspection, the owner must perform modifications. If a car fails 2 inspections, it is disqualified and will not race.
- 3. Cars are powered by gravity only. No motors of any kind are allowed, no rubber bands, no magnets, no batteries, no flywheels, no air bottles, etc.
- 4. Cars must be no heavier than 16 ounces.
- 5. Cars must be no longer than 7 inches, no wider than 2.75 inches, and no taller than 4.75 inches.
- 6. Cars must have exactly 4 wheels and exactly 2 axels. No dually tires are permitted.
- 7. The wheels that come with the kit shall be used. They may not be cut, drilled, beveled, or rounded. You may remove the seams and imprefections from the wheels. You may NOT add "treads" to the tire (such as a rubber band on the outside of the wheel) to retard slippage.
- 8. The axles may be filed, polished, and/or lubricated. Ball bearings are not permitted.
- 9. Cars must have 1.75 inch clearance between the insides of the wheels, and 3/8 inch clearance underneath is that the body does not rub on the track.
- 10. If a car is damaged during a race, the owner has 5 minutes to make repairs and re-weigh to race.
